



SOUTH DAKOTA LAW TO BE ENFORCED

*This just appeared on Dog Law Lists on the Web. If you plan to attend **any dog shows** or other animal activities in South Dakota, **read this carefully!!***

“Out-of-state animals to be accompanied by health certificate. All animals, including horses, cattle, sheep, hogs, **and dogs**, from other states imported for exhibition in South Dakota must be accompanied by health certificates. Copies of current **[within the last 30 days]** health certificates must be presented by the consignors of livestock to the management of the exhibition before the assignment of quarters or space to the livestock.” The same requirement exists for dogs from South Dakota. Apparently, this is a law that has been on the books since 1991 but hasn’t been enforced. There is a rising swell of questions as to WHY has this suddenly popped up after 20 years. WHO is behind this – Vets? PeTA??? HSUS??? The bottom line is: If you plan to attend *any* shows in Rapid City or anywhere else in the state, start making plans NOW to get the paperwork (\$\$\$) otherwise you will have wasted a *long* drive.

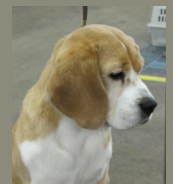
